Our plan will be to leave Glad Tidings around 1:00pm and return by 3:30pm. Each team can determine if carpooling to the facility would be most efficient.

 - Sessions are conducted from 9am—noon @ the main jail (Douglas County Correctional Facility, 710 S 17th St, Omaha).
